

ROHS (3) COMPLIANCE STATEMENT 2021 – FIBERCORE LIMITED

Fibercore is fully aware of the requirements under the **Restriction of Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Directive EU 2015/863 (RoHS 3)**, which adds four new restricted substances to the previous Directive 2011/65/EU or RoHS 2.

Fibercore products do not fall within the scope of the Directive and therefore Fibercore is not required to comply with the provisions of RoHS 3. Fibercore can confirm that its products:

1. do not contain any of the 10 restricted hazardous substances; Lead, Mercury, Cadmium, Hexavalent Chromium, Polybrominated biphenyls, Polybrominated biphenyl ethers, Bis(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate (DEHP), Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP), Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) and Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) as listed under Annex II of the Directive.
2. do not contain any electrical or electronic component and therefore does not require an EU declaration of Conformity or affixing the CE mark to our products.

Fibercore will continue to monitor any new amendments/ changes to the Directive and subsequently review its position with regards to compliance. Fibercore will also ensure that any new information is communicated to its customers, suppliers and stakeholders as required.
