

## CONFLICT MINERALS STATEMENT

Fibercore is fully aware of the issues associated with the use of Conflict Minerals addressed under section 1502 of the United States Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (the Dodd-Frank Act), concerning the use of the following minerals emanating from mining regions of the Congo (DRC) and adjacent countries (Conflict region) in the manufacture of products:

Gold (AU); Tantalum (Ta); Tungsten (W) and Tin (Sn)

Fibercore does not use these minerals in its manufacturing process or source them, therefore, we must rely on our suppliers to provide this information. Fibercore will continue to work closely with suppliers to ensure responsible sourcing and is committed to sourcing materials and supplies from companies that share our values with regard to human rights and environmental responsibility. If Fibercore becomes aware of a supplier that sources metals from a conflict area, Fibercore will take the appropriate actions to investigate and remedy the situation, including the termination of that supply contract.

Fibercore will continue to review and monitor its position regarding this matter, ensuring that its customers and stakeholders are made aware of any changes.
